ATTENTION: 2020 - 2021 Special Covid-19 Club Response to Potential School Schedule Changes

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Ada County is committed to ensuring a safe place for its members through unanticipated changes to traditional school year scheduling as a result of Covid-19. To that end, the below potential scenarios will result in the adjoining Club response to help aid parents / guardians in their planning for scenarios that may result in the coming year, subject to change. This is in addition to the normal Club calendar with altered schedule and Club holiday closures.

- School District Wide Closure / Alternate Day Schedule: The Clubs in that school district will revert to emergency care facilities, operating 7 am 6 pm to serve families who enroll through the parent portal with proper protocols for safety in place.
- One Specific School, Grade or Classroom Closure: The Clubs will support Central
 District Health and the school involved in their decision to quarantine students away
 from school and would therefore need to also limit access of the affected parties to
 the Club till the quarantine has been lifted.
- <u>Children Participating in E-learning, Home Based Schooling due to Covid-19:</u> The Club
 will maintain its regular school year operating hours, to serve families including those
 being schooled from home, who enroll through the parent portal with proper
 protocols for safety in place.
