A before & afterschool membership costs \$35/ week. This membership allows you to drop your child off at the Club as early as 7:00 AM. We ensure safe transport to school, and breakfast is provided by the school. After school, the Club will be open for afterschool programming until 7:00 PM.

Scholarships are available. No child is ever turned away for inability to pay.
